Division Chief of Emergency Medical Services

The Wayne Township Fire Department is currently seeking an individual to fill the position of Division Chief of Emergency Medical Services. We cover 36 square miles in Marion County, Indianapolis Indiana. In 2020, we responded on 16,533 emergency incidents with 4 ALS ambulances, 5 engines, 2 ladders, 1 Battalion Chief, 1 Safety Officer and 1 EMS Duty Officer.

The EMS Division Chief is responsible for the overall supervision and direction of the EMS Division. This includes response management, training/education, hiring, state certification, provider certification, personnel management and many other areas.

The desired candidate is currently a medical professional who has a passion for pre-hospital care. Personal and professional experience should include; personnel management, time management, EMS operations experience, professional & interpersonal communication skills, budgeting experience, EMS program oversight, a combination of education and experience equivalent to a Bachelor's degree and a desire to serve the community.
